



The Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program 2015

The Romanian-U.S. Fulbright Commission is pleased to announce the annual competition for the Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program for mid-career professionals who have a proven track record of leadership, a public service commitment and the capacity to take full advantage of a self-defined program of independent study at a leading U.S. university. The program offers a year of combined academic (NON-DEGREE) and professional work and awards a certificate from the U.S. Government.

The Humphrey Fellowship provides: round-trip international airfare and domestic travel (to required workshops/seminars), accident/sickness coverage, monthly maintenance allowance, computer subsidy and funding for books and professional activities. The Humphrey Program does not provide financial support for accompanying dependents.

► Eligible fields:

Sustainable Development (Agricultural and rural development; Economic development; Finance and banking; Natural resources, environmental policy, and climate change; Urban and regional planning); **Democratic Institution Building** (Communications/journalism; Law and human rights; Public policy analysis and public administration; Trafficking in persons policy and prevention; Technology policy and management; Human resource management); **Education** (Educational administration, planning and policy; Higher education administration; Teaching of English as a foreign language); **Public Health** (Public health policy and management; HIV/AIDS policy and prevention; Substance abuse education, treatment and prevention. *NOTE: Candidates in this field must have either a research background in the field or demonstrated ability to learn the results and policy implications of current research; candidates must complete a supplementary field-specific application page*)

► **Grant duration:** one year of non-degree graduate-level academic coursework and professional development activities.

► To be eligible for a Humphrey Fellowship, applicants must have:

- Romanian citizenship;
- first university degree;
- a minimum of five years of full-time professional experience (prior to August 2015) after completing a university degree;
- demonstrated leadership qualities and a record of public service;
- limited prior experience in the U.S.

Applicants should not be recent university graduates or university teachers/academic researchers with no management responsibilities (except in the fields of Substance Abuse Education, Prevention and Treatment and Teaching of English as a Foreign Language).

► Applicants are required to submit:

- an online application form (<http://apply.embark.com/student/humphrey/fellowship>);
- two letters of reference, directly submitted in the online application, one of which must be from an immediate supervisor of the applicant; the letters of reference should be written in English or should include an English translation;
- official academic transcripts and diplomas for all graduated levels (in electronic format); documents must be accompanied by complete English translations; high school transcripts and diploma are not required.



Application deadline: July 30, 2014

Only online applications will be accepted. Incomplete applications lead to the exclusion of the applicants from further selection process. Only shortlist candidates will be invited to interview phase in September.

Note: Test vouchers for TOEFL registration will be provided to the Romanian final nominees. Score reports will be required prior to September 30, 2014.
