Developing the national strategic framework for OS

KEY OBJECTIVES

The Strategic Recommendations for the development of Open Science in Romania promote, among other things, a completely new approach at national level for the time horizon 2021-2027:

- ⬡ a) ensuring OA to all scientific publications resulting from publicly funded projects,
- ⬡ b) introduction of data management plans (DMPs) taking into account the FAIR Principle and the overall EOSC vision

Developing the national strategic framework for OS

Challenges to be tackled

- Improving understanding of IPRs and other privacy issues and open licensing;
- Ensuring transparency of APCs;
- Developing mechanisms to ensure long-term preservation;
- Promoting new evaluation and rewards systems; new metrics for research and career evaluation
- Removing barriers for open science: engaging researchers and new users in open science (including citizen science);
- Developing long-term OS governance and monitoring mechanisms.
