


The UK case...



- Increases funding levels (to 2.4% GDP by 2027)
- Distributes the money more evenly
- Pro open science / open research
- Pro impact
 - What is the timescale for impact
 - Will the broad definition that has been developed so far be retained?
- Expectation that UK's research base will help the economic recovery



The Hare and the Tortoise






The Entrepreneurial State

- This keeps ideas in the public domain so that many players can benefit and innovate




Brain drains and privatisation of ideas








Dimensions on Google BigQuery






The establishment of preprints
