

# Multiple Roles



## Funder

*One-stop shop* for the EU “Partnerships”:  
46 ERA-NETs in H2020; EUREKA and EUROSTARS  
429 financed projects

## Grantee

1<sup>st</sup> place in Romania in terms of participation in projects financed through Horizon 2020 (65 projects, of which 40 in implementation)

3<sup>rd</sup> place as funds received from EC (12.1 mil euro)

19 CSA European Projects (the most at national level): supporting the development of different research areas

projects of support in public policy development for R&I: INTEREG IVC, INTERREG – Danube Transnational Programme, Interreg Europe.

# Romania & OA

APCs are eligible costs in the research projects publicly funded

Next step: RDM related costs to be eligible




