

- ➔ Establishment of bilateral partnerships between researchers from the RO & NO ➔ to submit a CRP funded under NO FM 2014-2021
- ➔ Call total budget: EUR 90.000 (level of grant 1.200 Euros)
- ➔ Eligible applicants: researchers from RO & NO from research organizations








About the mobility

Mobility  individual level


To one or more research organizations

Eligible expenditures

- ➔ Travel (including the cost travel from/to the airport)
- ➔ Subsistence allowance (per diem, internal transport and accommodation)
- ➔ Budget is in Euros, the exchange rate according to inforeuro




Timeline of the Call 2019

- ✓ Online submission system only: www.uefiscdi-direct.ro (NO paper support, email/fax);
- ✓ One single stage;
- ✓ Proposals must be in English language.



Submission process



✓ The statement of the applicant certifying, on his own responsibility, the correctness of the information contained in the application - signed only by the person requesting the mobility.

The mobility call - addressed to the researcher who will be involved in the future collaborative research project (deadline for applying – **the 16th of December 2019**);

✓ the period of the mobility - established by the Norwegian researcher in agreement with the partner from Romania, (maximum budget granted for a mobility: 1200 euros);

✓ **The invitation letter** from the Romanian:


- the exact period of the mobility;

- the intention of the partner to establish a partnership for the "Collaborative research project" Call;

✓ **Useful documents:**

- Short proposal for the agenda;

- Submission Guidelines.






Evaluation criteria

- ✓ C1: All sections in the online application are filled in correctly & the requested documents are uploaded
- ✓ C2: Employing organization of the applicant is eligible (research organization)
- ✓ C3: Planned activities/costs are eligible
- ✓ C4: Planned activities are within the objectives of this call

The researcher will receive an awarding letter!


Reimbursement process



- ✓ Exclusively online reimbursement www.uefiscdi-direct.ro (NO paper support, email/fax);
- ✓ Based on the written approval or a mobility contract;
- ✓ According to the Norwegian national law and reimbursement rules of the research organization;
- ✓ Reimbursement to employing organization;
- ✓ Within maximum one month after the mobility ended.






