

Submission process

The mobility call - addressed to the researcher who will be involved in the future collaborative research project (deadline for applying – the 16th of December 2019);

- ✓ Useful documents:

✓ the period of the mobility - established by the Norwegian researcher in agreement with the partner from Romania, (maximum budget granted for a mobility: 1200 euros);

The invitation letter from the Romanian:

- the exact period of the mobility;

- the intention of the partner to establish a partnership for the "Collaborative research project" Call;

- Short proposal for the agenda;

- Submission Guidelines.



Evaluation criteria

- C1: All sections in the online application are filled in correctly & the requested documents are uploaded
- ✓ C2: Employing organization of the applicant is eligible (research organization)
- ✓ C3: Planned activities/costs are eligible
- C4: Planned activities are within the objectives of this call


According to the Norwegian national law and reimbursement rules of the research organization;



 \geq 26 contracts signed & 3 awarding letters ➤ 33.300 euros requested


