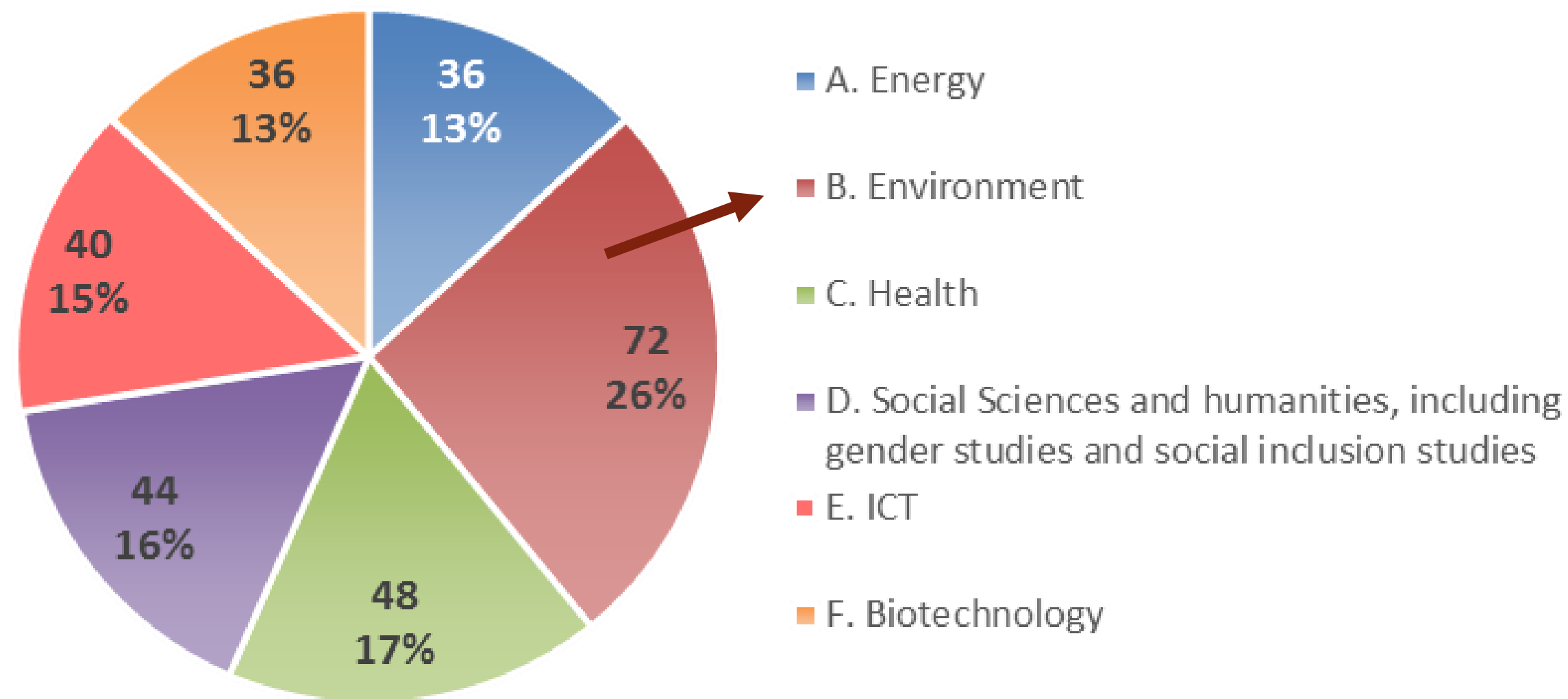

Submitted Projects Distribution by Main Thematic Area



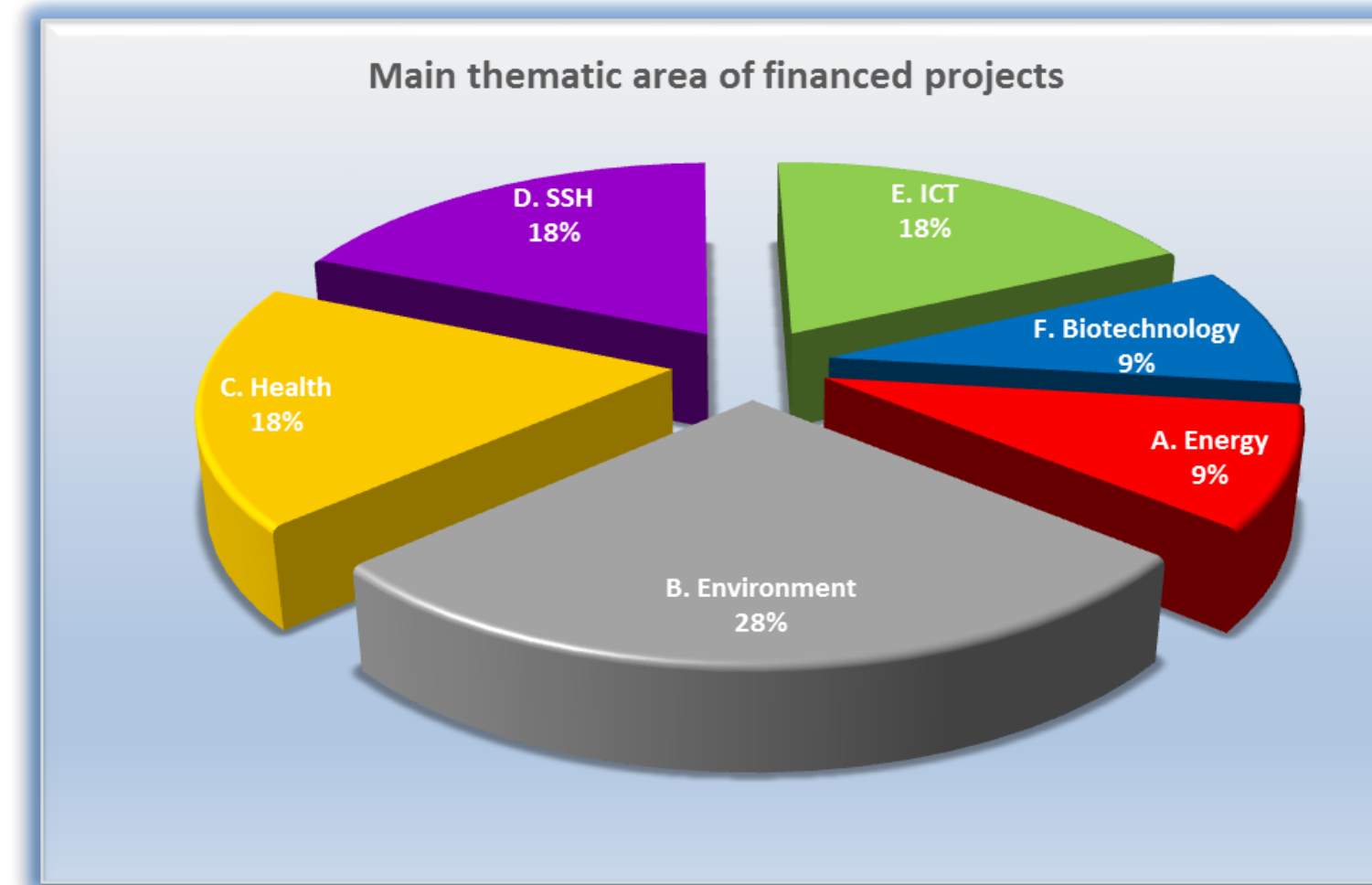

- ✓ basic and applied research activities
- ✓ 6 thematic areas + associated key topics: energy (5); environment (5); health (4); social sciences and humanities including gender studies and social inclusion studies (6); ICT (3); biotechnology (4)

Note: the project proposal could cover up to 3 key topics; the main key topic must be under the main thematic area and other possible 2 key topics could be from other thematic areas



A. Energy:

1. Innovative materials and technologies for energy storage;
2. Energy efficiency within the process of generation, transmission, smart grids distribution and at the consumer/end user;
3. Eco-friendly-environmental technologies for energy production/generation;
4. Energy sources – diversification/balance;
5. Carbon capture and storage

B. Environment:

1. Management of emerging pollutants in aquatic systems (impact, remediation and recycling techniques) to improve ecosystem services of water resources and wetlands;
2. Ecosystems monitoring, affected by climate change, management of biodiversity, biosafety, protection and ecological restoration;
3. Environmental impact and risk assessment of the modern, new and emerging technologies and products (can include also climate change);
4. Resources, technologies and tools for circular economy;
5. Research on the climate changes and/or extreme natural phenomenon impact on natural and anthropogenic systems.

C. Health:

1. Developing patient-centred strategies to fight cancer;
2. Translational medicine in regenerative medicine, neurodegenerative and rare diseases;
3. Improving public health by implementing evidence-based preventive strategies;
4. Roma inclusion and empowerment.

D. Social Sciences and humanities, including gender studies and social inclusion studies:

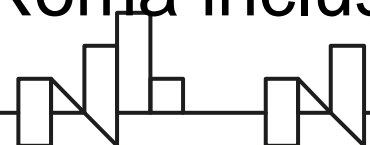
1. Migration, mobility, diaspora;
2. Participative democracy, social and cultural innovation, economic growth;
3. Cosmopolitanism and nationalism;
4. Social and economic inclusion of disadvantages groups;
5. Digitization and accessibility of the cultural heritage;
6. Roma inclusion and empowerment.

E. ICT:

1. Cyber security, personal data protection, protection of critical infrastructures and services;
2. Technologies, instruments and methods for software development – artificial intelligence (AI) & cloud computing;
3. Advanced robotics, mechatronics and additive manufacturing technologies (3D printing, bio-printing);
4. Technologies and applications of Big Data and/or Internet of things (IoT) for public administration, education, agriculture, health, banking etc.

F. Biotechnology:

1. Biotechnology for agriculture, aquaculture, forestry and biomass production;
2. Industrial and food biotechnology;
3. Biotechnology for health, medicine and related industries;
4. Integrated environmental biotechnology.

✓ Project Promoter (PP):

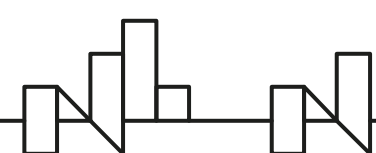
Research organizations, as defined in the Community Framework for State Aid for RDI (2014/C 198/01), **established in RO**

✓ Project Partners (pp):

Research organizations and companies (SMEs and large enterprises) established in RO or NO **(at least one from NO)**

✓ Principal Investigator (PI):

- Project coordinator
- PI (of any nationality) could be PI for one single submitted proposal
- A researcher who is PI of an ongoing project funded under EEA Grants Call 2018 cannot be in the same time a PI of a new project within the current call

Evaluation - criteria

Criterion 0: *Relevance in relation to the objectives and priorities of the call/research programme – Yes/No*

Criterion 1: *Scientific and/or technical excellence – weight of 50%; max. 5 points*

Criterion 2: *Quality and efficiency of the implementation and management, including quality and implementation capacity of the applicants and contribution to capacity and competence building
– weight of 20%; max. 5 points*

Criterion 3: *Potential impact through the development, dissemination and use of project results
– weight of 30%; max. 5 points*

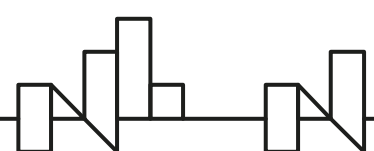


PO:

- Prepares 7 preliminary ranking lists
(6 lists for each thematic areas and one for projects addressed Roma population issues)
- Provides access to documents for PC
- Suggests grant amount/proposal
(also PO may apply minor budget cuts across proposals but not exceeding 3% of the requested budget)

PC:

- Decides about the final ranking order
- *Criteria for ranking applied if case:*
 - ✓ *Bilateral cooperation*
 - ✓ *Young researchers*
 - ✓ *Gender balance in the project*
- **Recommends for funding**
- Prepares possible reserve list

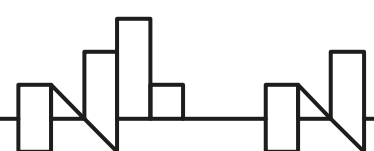


Negotiation *(see Guideline for applicants)*

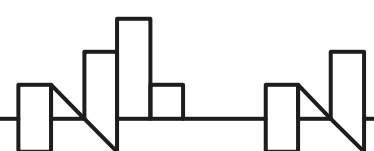
- PP are invited at PO location for discussions; the applicants may receive requests for further administrative, legal, technical and financial information necessary for the preparation of the project contract;

Contracting *(see Guideline for applicants)*

- Contract (signed between PO and PP, in RO language)

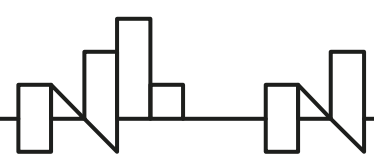


- Partnership Agreement (between PP and pps, in ENG) – DESCAs model (template available at: <https://uefiscdi.gov.ro/index.php>)
 - ✓ provisions on the roles and responsibilities of the parties;
 - ✓ provisions on the financial arrangements between parties;
 - ✓ provisions on audits on Project Partners;
 - ✓ a detailed budget;
 - ✓ intellectual property rights;
 - ✓ provisions on dispute resolutions.





- ✓ Currency used for the proposal submission: EURO

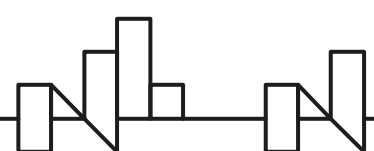

**subcontract specific services (no more than 15% of the total project budget); applicable rules for public procurement*

✓ Indirect costs (overheads)

RO applicants: must apply a flat rate of 25% of total direct eligible costs, excluding direct eligible costs for subcontracting (could include salaries for administrative staff which are not part of staff costs)

NO partners: In case the project grant takes the form of standard scales of unit costs, the flat rate of 25% for indirect costs shall not be applied for the partner in question.

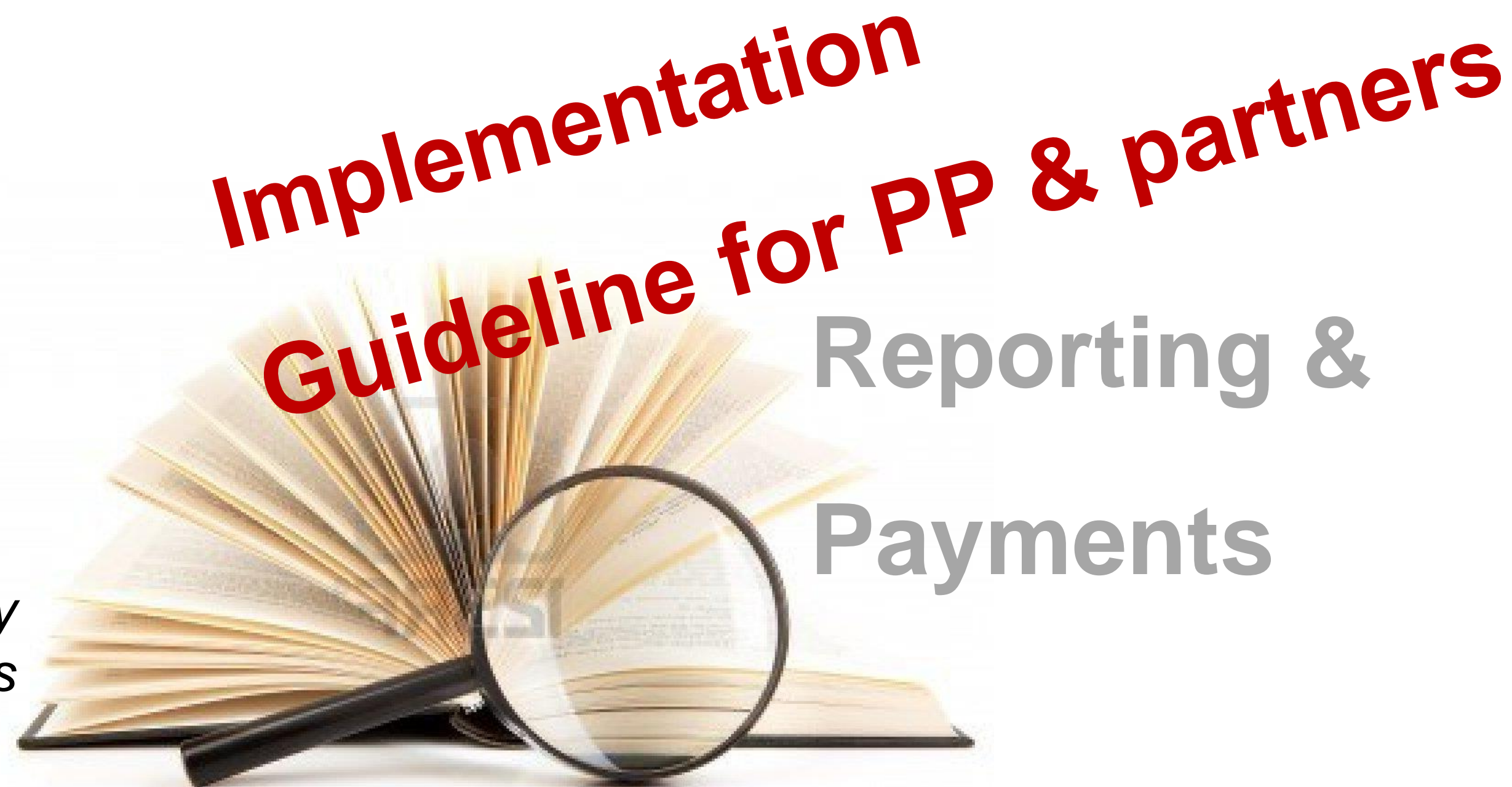

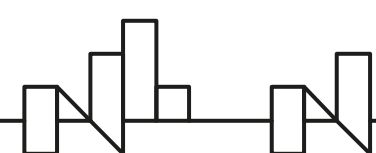

Payments

**proof of expenditures shall not be submitted by PP or pp where the total programme grant is less than 325.000 Euro!*

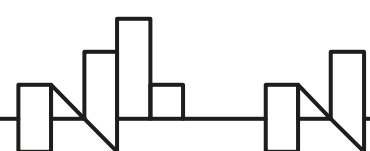

Payments

- payments of the project grant can take the form of advance payment, interim payments and final payment;
- the purpose of the advance payment and the annual interim payments is to ensure that the PP and partner(s) have a positive cash flow during the project implementation;
- the advance payment of a percentage of the total grant amount shall be made upon signature of the contract between the PO and the PP;
 - it should cover the first year of the implementation of the project;
- the interim payments will ensure positive cash flow for all subsequent reporting periods (year);
 - it will be granted at the beginning of the subsequent reporting periods and will be calculated based on the cash balance at the end of the previous reporting period;
- payments are made by the PO to the PP within 15 days after the PO's approval of payment requests;
- the PP should ensure that all appropriate payments to the other partner(s) are made without unjustified delay and no later than 15 days after receiving of the payment from the PO.



Reporting - using the forms and templates provided in the www.uefiscdi-direct.ro platform

The Project Promoter will report to the Program Operator, in RON, all the expenses incurred at its own level and by its Romanian Project Partners.

The Project Promoter will report to the Program Operator, in EURO, all the expenses incurred by the NO partners.

NO partners will report to Project Promoter in EURO.

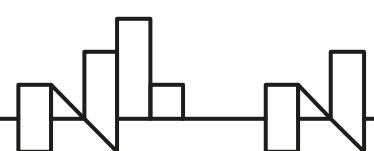
