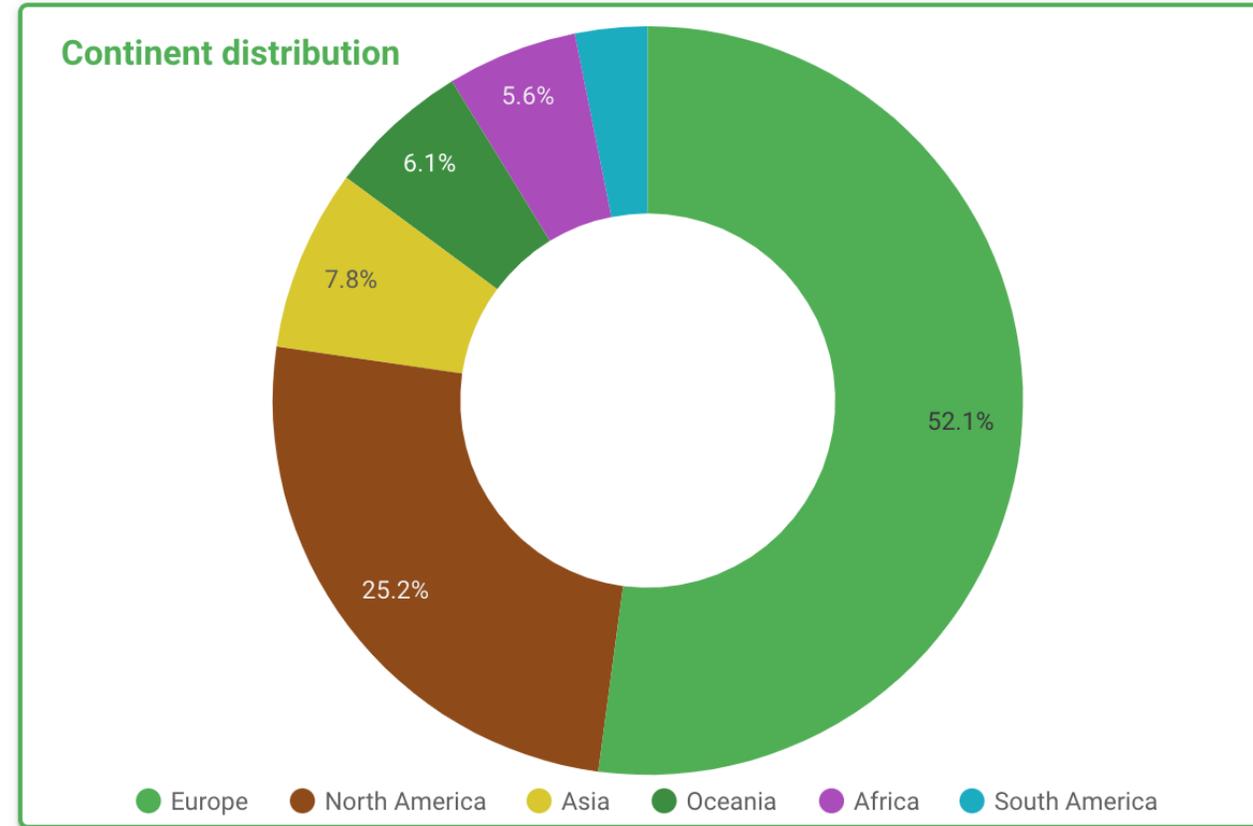
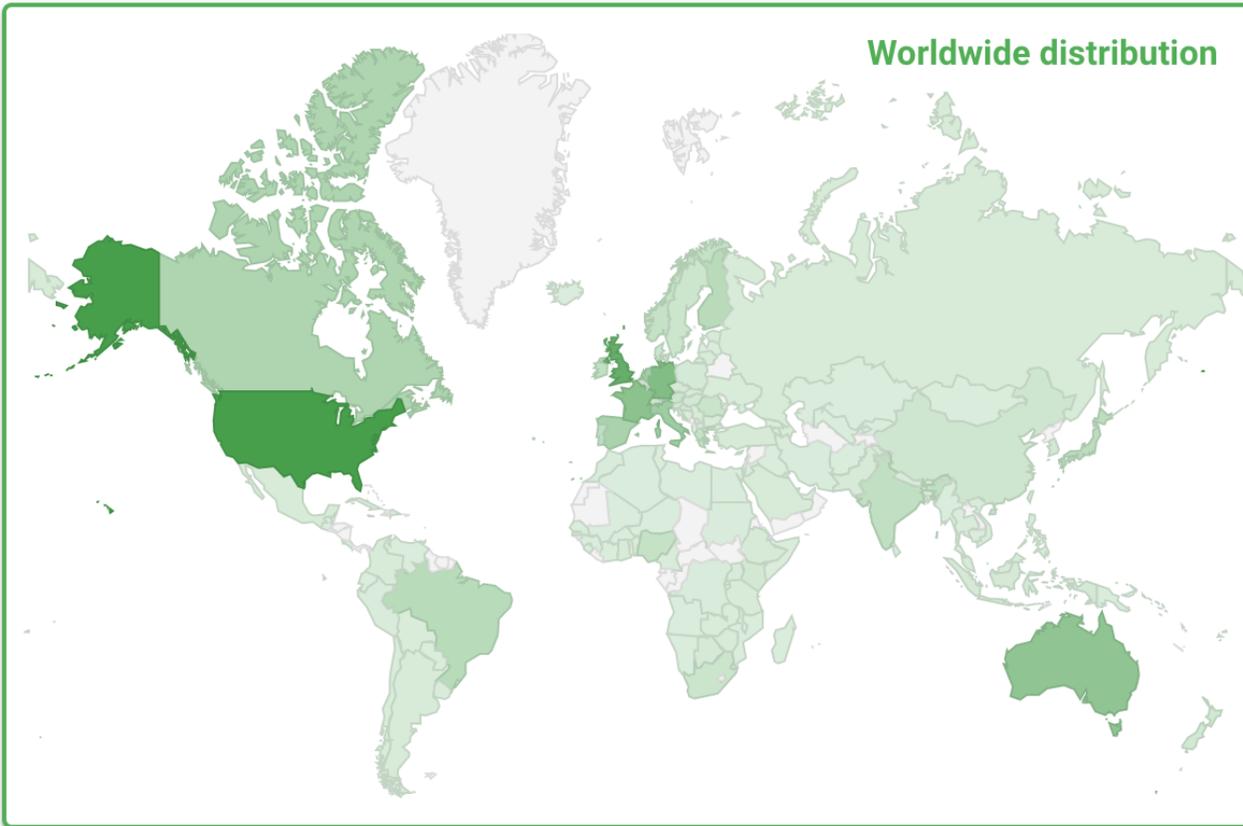

The technical heart of RDA ... 91 groups

Working Groups

- develop and implement tools, policy, practices & products for data management that are adopted and used by projects, organisations, communities
- TIMING: 12-18 MONTHS
- TOTAL: 34 Working Groups

RECOMMENDATIONS: Concrete deliverables - "Running code", tools, standards, etc.

Interest Groups

- focus on solving a specific data sharing problem and identifying what kind of infrastructure needs to be built.
- TIMING: as long as group is active
- TOTAL: 57 Interest Groups

OUTPUT: Possibly case statements for new WGs, guidelines, best practice, etc.





RDA Recommendations & Outputs

RECOMMENDATIONS

Equivalent of the “specifications” or “standards” that other organisations create and endorse.

23 Recommendations
of which 8 ICT Technical Specifications

SUPPORTING OUTPUTS

Outputs of RDA WGs and IGs that are fruit of RDA work, but are not necessarily adoptable bridges.

14 Supporting Outputs

OTHER OUTPUTS

Anything a WG or IG wants to register and report, e.g. workshop reports, articles, survey results, etc.

RDA COVID19 Background context

- European Commission asked RDA to establish a working group to ensure international, neutral and inclusive approach.
- RDA supporting a rapid response / fast track approach e.g. quicker approval of case statement, results in weeks not years.
- Sought international co-chairs with domain expertise and links in national / regional Open Science Commons.

Working group aims

- To ***define detailed practical guidelines*** on data sharing under the present COVID-19 circumstances to help stakeholders follow best practices to maximize the efficiency and impact of their work.
- To develop guidelines for policymakers to maximise timely data sharing and appropriate responses in such health emergencies e.g. OECD policy brief



Planned WG outputs

- Best practice guidelines per sub-group and overall
- Guidelines to highlight key resources (e.g. key datasets, standards, tools, repositories etc)
- A decision tree tool to facilitate navigation to specific resources by different stakeholders
- Recommendations for researchers and policymakers to help maximise data sharing

Template for guidelines

● **Scope:** A description of the area explaining what fields of study are in scope and out of scope

● **Resources:** An annotated list of available resources for the area, including:

- Guidelines
- Research resources such as data, articles, software, compute
- Contacts

● **Recommendations:** A short summary of recommendations.

- Data collections
- Documentation, standards and data quality
- Storage and backup
- Legal and ethical requirements
- Data sharing and long-term preservation
- Data management responsibilities and resources

● **Possible structure of Recommendations** (to be revised by SGs and Moderators)

Propose to structure recommendations according to Science Europe core requirements for DMPs



Template for resources catalogue

Work in Progress: suggestions for structure [HERE](#)

- **Name of the resource** (Limited length text field)
- **Description** (Limited length text field)
- Creator/owner of the resource
- Publication date (if applicable)
- **Resource type** dataset, publication, guideline, policy, etc.
- Language e.g. en, fr
- **URL / Persistent Identifier**
- Access / license e.g. open, CC-BY, MIT etc
- Other
- **Relevant sub-group(s)**: omics, clinical, epi, social, community participation



Mandatory = Green



Tentative timeline - an iterative approach

- **Approach**
 - Release first version ASAP and then continuous revision
 - Much parallel working to condense timescale
- **7-10 April**
 - Group solidification (7-9 Apr)
 - Collection of lists of resources (7-21 Apr)
- **14-21 April**
 - Collection of initial text in guidelines and recommendations (14-21 Apr)
 - Iterative cleaning and updating of resources (14-21 Apr)
- **21- 24 April**
 - Review and revise guidelines and recommendations (21-24 Apr)
- **First release (24 April)**
 - Continuous expansion and revision - releases 1st May, 8 May, ...

Community participation: Potential approach / timeline

- Develop a prioritised list of things to work on by Wednesday 15 April
- Form c.6-7 teams of about 15 to get allocated to work on the topics
- Each group will pick up a single task, in priority order, until we run out of groups
- Each group works on their topics for 5 days (ie: until Sunday)
- On Monday, each team will be allocated a different topic for review over the next 2 days (ie: Monday & Tuesday)
- Each group resumes work on their original topic afterwards, incorporating the review comments they have received from another group
- Towards the later part of the 3 weeks, we should look to form a small editorial team, which will look to bring it all together into a coherent piece of work
