







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



ORIGIN OF THE OUR PHD STUDENTS (ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18)










APPLICATIONS BY CONTINENT





Nationality of the applicants (> 1 candidate per country)





3.2.2. EVALUATION (I)

- 3 experts for each CV
- No consensus panel, all evaluations are scored and the average of the 3 experts is calculated by the system
- Evaluation criteria:
 - Academic profile: Weight (40%)
 - Other merits (including research and previous professional experience): Weight (30%)
 - Reference letters: Weight (10%)
 - Motivation letter, detailing the reasons why the candidate believes s/he is a good fit for the position: Weight (20%)
- New evaluation app developed by the management team
- Evaluations count as 50% of final score







3.2.2. EVALUATION (II)

- For the 2017 call, the experts were found through URV's network of contacts
- For the 2018 call, URV's contact network was supplemented by EURAXESS
- Selected by the management team, with no input from the supervisors (avoid conflicts of interest)
- Randomly appointed within their research discipline
- Access to documentation of the candidate and research Project
- Online evaluation process
- Evaluators were paid 41€/CV evaluated 91,700 € paid in total







3.2. SELECTION PROCESSES

3.2.3. INTERVIEWS AND FINAL SELECTION

- 1 selection committee for each position (minimum 3 members)
- Conduct interviews (via Skype) with at least top 3 candidates (most often more) from the evaluation stage
- Selection criteria:
 - Academic profile: Weight 30%
 - Professional profile: Weight 30%
 - Personal profile: Weight 30%
 - Knowledge about the PhD position and the university environment: Weight 10%
- Final scoring:
 - The evaluation report from the Evaluation Committees: Weight 50%
 - The individual scoring of the interviews: Weight 50%
