Goals of PSF Specific Support

Reforms to stimulate innovative entrepreneurship and to create an environment conducive to the growth of technological start-ups

Panel tasked to:

- 1. Assess the incipient RO innovative entrepreneurship, start-up and scale-up ecosystem
- 2. Identify and recommend measures and specific instruments strengthen it

INVESTMENT IN R&D > R&D SPENDING

Although R&D intensity improved in 2015, it remains one of the lowest in the EU The lack of progress towards the national target impedes the building-up of R&I capacities
