Phase 1 - Concept & Feasibility Assessment

- Proposal 10 pages
- Feasibility study
- ~6 months
- € **50,000** per project
- Up to 3 coaching days

⇒ Outcome:

feasibility assessment with a more elaborated business plan









- Proposal 30 pages: feasibility assessment+ full business plan
- € 0.5 -€2.5 million
- 70% co-financing
- Up to 12 days coaching
- 1-2 years

⇒ Outcome:

- Ready to launch on the market
- Commercialization strategy & plan to attract investors





SMEI- main changes





How do we evaluate?

Eligibility

- Profit-SMEs
- <250 employees
- <€50 million turnover/ balance sheet <€43 million
- SME based in EU MS or H2020 Associated Countries
- Single SME or consortium SMEs

Award criteria:

- IMPACT
- EXCELLENCE
- IMPLEMENTATION

Threshold

- Scores 0-5: pass mark 4 for each award criterion
- Weighting:
- impact 50%;
- excellence 25%;
- implementation 25%
- Median pass mark: 13 points out of the total

Impact



- ✓ Market (willing to pay) customers and end-users
- ✓ Competition on the market
- ✓ Business Model your revenue model strategy and stakeholders map - how to scale-up
- ✓ **Financing** capital structure- profit/loss turnover-(phase 2: how to get the 30% for the project)
- ✓ EU/global dimension
- ✓ Knowledge protection (IPR management)
- ✓ Jobs created in Europe

- ✓ Innovative product/process/service
- √ Viable & Disruptive technology
- ✓ Description Technology Readiness TRL 6
- ✓ Added Market value

Technological Readiness Level



- √ TRL 1 basic principles observed
- √ TRL 2 technology concept formulated
- √ TRL 3 experimental proof of concept

- ✓ TRL 5 technology validated in relevant environment
- ✓ TRL 6 technology demonstrated in relevant environment (industrially relevant environment in the case of key enabling technologies)
- ✓ TRL 7 system prototype demonstration in operational environment
- ✓ TRL 8 system complete and qualified
- ✓ TRL 9 actual system proven in operational environment (competitive manufacturing in the case of key enabling technologies; or in space)






Evaluation process for Ph2









SMEs per country (Phase 2 – All topics)








SME instrument success rate per country













Funded SMEs in numbers Phase 1 – 2014-2016








Funded SMEs in numbers Phase 2 - 2014-2016
